

## **BA/B Sc /B Com 1<sup>st</sup> Semester (CBCS) online Admission 2018-2019**

Name of the website- [onlineadmissionbrc.org.in](http://onlineadmissionbrc.org.in)

### **Rules & Regulations:**

Only candidate who have passed XII (10+2) in 2015, 2016, 2017 & 2018 and those who have not passed B. A. / B. Com. / B. Sc. will be considered.

An applicant passed H.S. with at least 45% marks in aggregate is eligible to apply. However, minimum marks required for Admission in General course in Day and Evening shift is 50% and 45% marks is required for the Morning shift.

There is a minimum % of marks required for the application in different honours subjects (Please see Table-1).

**Separate Application is required for Morning, Day and Evening shift. Also Separate Application is required both for Honours and General course.**

For change in Stream (e.g. from Science to Arts and vice versa or Commerce to Arts etc.) candidate will have to pay full Admission fee again.

For change in honours subject within the same stream only difference amount will be paid.

For change in Shift (e.g. from Morning to Day or Evening to Day etc.) full Admission fee will be paid.

All payment will be made through online system. No cash deposit will be entertained. Application fee is Rs.200/- both Honours and General Course.

**Application fee paid as well as amount deposited at the time of Admission will not be refundable.**

For Honours in Bio-Science candidate must be passed in Chemistry.

For Honours in Economics candidate must be passed in Mathematics.

For Honours in Anthropology required marks in English is 55 with biology or Sociology or Anthropology as a combination subject.

Subject combinations are according to the Burdwan University CBCS Syllabus. Both for Honours and General Candidate, Generic Elective (GE) and General Subject will be allotted on the Verification Table at the time of Admission.

Environment studies will not be considered in deriving aggregate or % of marks.

Those candidates who have Hindi as a language subject in HS, please put the marks of Hindi in place of Bengali and calculate merit point. Please inform it at the time of verification.

## **Application Process:**

**All eligible candidates are required to register online through internet. Registration includes entries of student details. Successful registration means creation of registration id and password.**

Thereafter the system will automatically generate candidate e-challan for payment of registration fees worth **Rs.200/-**. For Date of registration please follow the notice in the College website. If payment is not corroborated by bank concerned, the options exercised will stand automatically cancelled.

To calculate % of marks at 10<sup>th</sup> level consider aggregate marks in Madhyamik without additional marks.

To calculate % of marks at 12<sup>th</sup> level, add marks of 2 languages + best 3 elective subjects studied.

In case of CBSE and ICSE (10 standard), if marks of Board exam be available, add up to final aggregate. If marks of Board Exam are not available the marks given by the Institute and approved by the concerned Board will be taken into account for calculation of % of marks.

In case, marks are not awarded but grade points (GP) are awarded, GP is to be converted into marks on 100 point scale. If letter grades with range of marks for the letter grades are given, then the mid value of the range of a particular letter grade will be considered for determination of % of marks.

**Environment studies will not be considered in deriving aggregate of marks.**

In case of CBSE and ISC (12 standard), consider 2 or 1 language as available + 3 best elective subjects and find aggregate marks. If one language is available, it is doubled to calculate the aggregate marks.

**Those candidates who have Hindi as a language subject in HS, please put the marks of Hindi in place of Bengali and calculate merit point. Please inform it at the time of verification.**

Merit list will be generated on the basis of category, honours subjects, and intake capacity. All reserved candidates shall be considered in unreserved list as well as reserved list. If such a candidate be found eligible for admission in both lists and he/she gets admission, he/she will be considered to have filled in the unreserved list. In this case, his/her name will be deleted from both lists.

An applicant will get scope for viewing his/her status by logging in. Also SMS information of allotted choices will be sent to applicant. If an applicant finds any seat allotted to him /her in one subject opted for and he/she opts for admission, he/she will click for apply and then an e-challan and an admission document will be generated. Instantly this choice will be locked in his/her favour and he/she will get an SMS for provisional admission. The bank will inform the system database about the payment. The payment document and admission document together will serve as a record for provisional admission of the student. Provisional admission is to be ultimately approved by the college on verification of testimonials.

To approve his/her provisional admission, the candidate should reach the college with original and two photocopies of all testimonials including reservation certificate for verification by college authority. However, if any candidate does not make any contact with

the college for verification of his / her testimonials and other admission related documents within the stipulated time, then his / her admission will be treated as cancelled and all allotments in his /her favour up to the next phase would be cancelled. If any discrepancies found during verification of original testimonials, the college authority will have the right to reject the admission of the student.

Duration for 1<sup>st</sup> Phase admission will be two days. The third day will be reserved for verification of the 1<sup>st</sup> phase of admission. Merit list will be updated after a gap of one day and provisional admission of the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase will be commenced. Duration of the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase admission will also be 2 days (i.e. fourth and fifth days). The sixth days will be reserved for verification of the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of admission. Merit list for 3<sup>rd</sup> phase will be updated on the seventh day. The process is going on until the total intake capacity is filled up.

The candidate treated as reserved by the Government of West Bengal will be only considered. Reserved in other states will be considered as unreserved candidate.

### **Tie- breaking of grade points:**

If multiple students have same GP up to 4 decimal places, following points are to be considered sequentially-

- i) Marks obtained at 10+2 level of the honours subject sought will be doubled to break a tie.
- ii) Total marks of H S will be considered if the tie persists.
- iii) Finally marks of 1<sup>st</sup> language will be considered.

## Summary of the online Admission Process:

1. Admission will be completely done through online system.
2. Students passing in **2015, 2016, 2017 & 2018** may apply. **Separate Applications are needed for Honours and General courses.**
3. Online Admission Form fill up date:- **Follow the notice in the College website.**
4. Online Admission Portal :- [WWW.onlineadmissionbrc.org.in](http://WWW.onlineadmissionbrc.org.in)
5. Registration fees (Rs.200/-) will be paid through online system (**NET Banking, Credit card, Debit card etc.**).
6. After completion of form fill up click on submit, payment mode will open.  
After completion of payment, applicants will have to wait until merit list is published.
7. After publication of merit list, you may get **SMS alert** if your name is enlisted in the merit list and then follow our website. After enlisted in the merit list, go to Online Admission Portal :- [WWW.onlineadmissionbrc.org.in](http://WWW.onlineadmissionbrc.org.in) then login with User ID and Password which you have got during form fill up. After login you will see your status in the merit list.
8. After choice of Honours subject, proceed for online payment of Admission fees through online (**NET Banking, Credit card, Debit card etc.**)
9. Admission process will be completed only **after verification of Original documents. Please bring all the original testimonials including reservation certificate, Registration and Admission fees payment slip and application form.**
10. Verification will have to be done in the Department concerned.  
**Documents needed for verification: All the original testimonials (including reservation certificate) with two photocopies, Admission documents and Payment documents.**
11. If any discrepancies found during verification of original documents, the College Authority will have the right to reject the admission of the student.
12. Under any circumstances the necessary fees which have been deposited at the time of admission are not entitled for any refund.
13. Those candidates who have Hindi as a language subject in HS, please put the marks of Hindi in place of Bengali and calculate merit point. Please inform it at the time of verification.
